Artemisa Rocha Dores holds a PhD. in Biomedical Sciences (Neuroscience) by the Institute of Biomedical Sciences Abel Salazar (ICBAS), University of Porto. She is graduated in Psychology by the University of Minho, with specialization in the Clinical and Health fields. She concluded her Master's degree in Psychology, with specialization in Cognitive Sciences, in the same institution. Currently, she is performing their postdoc, with the project "Psychobiological Approach to Pathological and Problematic Gambling" (e.g., Near-miss in the pathological and problematic gambling: behavioral and EEG studies). She develops a program for preventing youth risk behavior in collaboration with the Intervention Division in Addictive Behaviours and Dependencies (DICAD, <http://www.arslvt.min-saude.pt>), a national governmental organization.

She was awarded with a scholarship by the Foundation for Science and Technology (FCT). She has developed activities in the domains of the Cognitive Neurosciences - Neuropsychology (memory, attention, perception, executive functions and neurocognitive rehabilitation). Her doctoral thesis focuses on "The effect of virtual reality in cognitive rehabilitation: methodological and technological innovations".

She is a Professor at the Polytechnic of Porto, School of Health (ESS - P. Porto), where she is integrated since 2000. She is a lecturer/professor of different disciplines, such as Cognitive Rehabilitation, Neuropsychological Assessment and Educational Psychology. She is a visiting professor at the Faculty of Psychology and Educational Sciences of the University of Porto (FPCEUP) and at the Health Sciences

Institute of the Catholic University. She is the Coordinator of the scientific area of Social and Human Sciences and Coordinator of the Student Support Office, and Coordinator of the Postgraduation of Neurological Rehabilitation in Acquired Brain Injury among other positions in the management bodies of the Faculty.

She is member of the Rehabilitation Research Center (P. Porto-ESS and FPCEUP) and of the Neuropsychophysiology Laboratory (FPCEUP). She is member of the European project "THERAPY 2.0 - Counselling and Therapeutic Interactions with Digital Natives" (ERASMUS +) and of the project "COST CA16207, European Network for Problematic Usage of the Internet". In addition to book chapters, she has published papers, both in national and international journals. She is also an invited peer-reviewer of some international journals. Her main research interests are neurocognitive rehabilitation, technology, pathological gambling and clinical communication.
